


Lecturing – My instructor uses lectures to deliver course information or gives instructions on most assignments or both.




Group collaboration – My instructor gives us problems to solve in groups, engages us in small group discussions and organize class projects.


Manipulating – My instructor lets us learn by doing – engaging us in application activities, projects, experiments, or constructing most things we're learning about.


Reading – My instructor gives a text or handout reading assignment on a regular basis.










Rank your preferred learning style: Visual Presentation



Rank your preferred learning style: Group Collaboration








Rank your preferred learning style: Manipulating








Rank your preferred learning style: Reading
